Xerox Secure Access is a security option for your Xerox[®] advanced multifunction systems. It integrates with your existing employee/student ID badge solution. A flexible and convenient identification system, Secure Access enables users to log in to a Xerox[®] multifunction system with a swipe of their magnetic or proximity ID card. Users have a personalised interface which improves their print-related productivity.

IT managers are looking for ways to protect all assets on their network. Multifunction systems are a logical place to secure networks and enhance document information security. Additionally, in today's regulatory climate, businesses need sophisticated ways of safeguarding their data. Many organisations rate network security as their foremost IT challenge.

To meet these needs years ago, Xerox developed Network Authentication, which requires users to enter a user ID and password at the device. Some environments require a more convenient and streamlined method. So Xerox created Xerox Secure Access, which gives organisations with an existing card-based ID system a quick and easy method of identifying users at the multifunction system. Users gain access to the device with one swipe of their ID badge. For an extra layer of security, two-factor authentication is an option. A PIN or password may be required.

How it works

The Secure Access solution leverages an organisation's existing ID infrastructure without impacting existing systems. With Secure Access in place, a single identification step will log the user into the device for access to all walk-up features. All communication to and from the multifunction system, card reader and authentication server will be secured using industry-standard encryption mechanisms.

Secure Access is also IT-friendly as the automatic access card registration feature allows new users to self-register their cards. The first time new users swipe their card they will be prompted to link their card with Secure Access by entering their user account login. Once this is done, the card is associated with Secure Access and users will have access to all associated multifunction printers.

Gain flexibility with Follow-You print

Follow-You print, a feature of Secure Access, makes it easy for people to securely print their documents to the most convenient device on the network. Simply submit a document to a secure print queue, walk up to any device equipped with Secure Access and swipe an ID card to release the print job.

Secure Access works with all Xerox® EIP-enabled multifunction systems

Optionally, when combined with Xerox Extensible Interface Platform™ (EIP), there are added Follow-You printing features available. Individuals can select how many prints they need, delete the document or securely store it to print again later. No longer will people waste time and money printing documents they never collect. The documents are only printed when you swipe your ID card and release them at the system. This means there's no need to worry about someone seeing a confidential document that you send to the printer.

Save user time

Secure Access saves steps by giving the multifunction system the ability to populate certain user information fields when the user signs in. For example, the device will automatically fill in the "From" field when using scan-to-email.

Reduce IT support

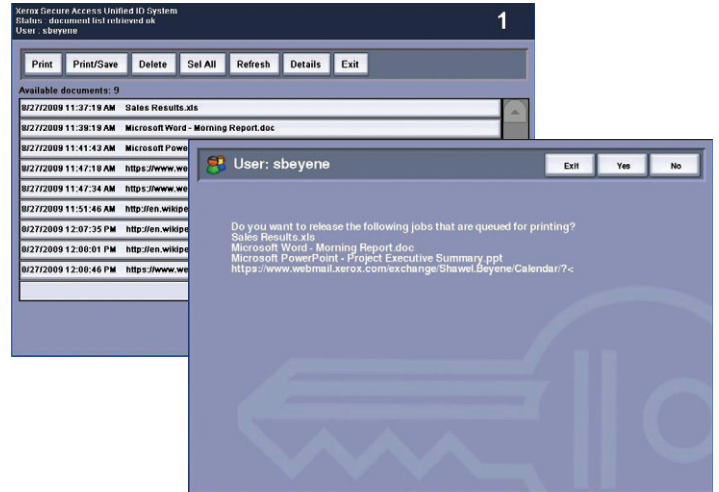
Secure Access is easily administered using a task-based management console that seamlessly integrates with the customer's existing network card-identification infrastructure.
